Dear Neighbours,

8build would like to let you know that since our previous March Newsletter we have undertaken the below work on site:

- Investigation works throughout Egyptian and Dudley House including Level 1 terrace.
- Exposing the steel to lightwells to enable infill works.
- Concrete slab pour to Level 6 and Level 1 Metal Deck.
- Asbestos strip out completed to Egyptian House Lift.
- Hoarding being re-erected following UKPN works.
- Installation of door to level 4 Foxglove.
- Mock up windows to Level 1 are now completed.
- Removal of slab in Restaurant to allow waterproofing works.
- Lighting, Fire alarm and Security install to Restaurant.
- Removal of dumbwaiter in restaurant.

Works over the next 2-week period

8build will continue and start the below works:

- Exposing the steel to lightwells to enable infill works.
- Concrete slab pour following Metal deck installation to Level2.
- Hoarding being re-erected following UKPN works.
- Continuation of measured surveys and point cloud surveys.
- Making good around strengthening works.
- Strengthening works to columns.
- Removal of dumbwaiter in Restaurant.
- Concrete slab pour in Restaurant ready for waterproofing.
- Continue installation of Fire alarm, Lighting and Security to Restaurant

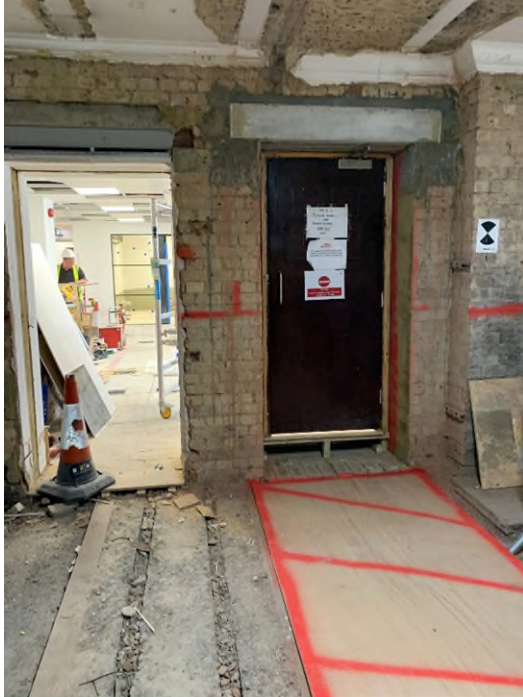
